[Ordinance to Establishment of Center for Advanced Study at IIIT Allahabad](#)

1. **Subject:** Ordinance to Establishment of Center for Advanced Study at IIIT Allahabad.

2. **Preamble:**

In exercise of the powers vested in the Board vide Section IV and V of the Statutes of the Institute, the Board had in its earlier meeting accorded it in principle concurrence for the establishment of Center for Advanced Study in the Institute.

The Institute since already has four departments looking into the areas of IT, ECE, Ms and AS, it has been envisaged that the proposed Centers shall be inter-disciplinary in nature, drawing strengths from at least two or more departments of the Institute. Such Center shall be classified as an academic unit for the purpose of the Statutes of Institute and shall have the functions as her-in follows:

3. Each such 'Centre' shall be financially self-sustaining and be liable to meet its expenses for the funds generated by itself. Institute may like to encourage the 'Centers' through providing loan / seed money / Start-up grant as felt proper. No regular appointments of any kind shall be offered by the 'Centre'.
4. The 'Centre' shall be free to run Programmes/ Courses, Specialized Courses, Organize Seminars / Symposiums / Workshops / Conferences etc. from the funds available with the Centre.
5. The 'Centre' shall be operated through a 'Centre Head' assisted by 'Core Group' comprising largely of faculty members, who have been actively involved in research or have related research publications or have sponsored project, all related to the Centre Theme. The Centre may be assisted by an Advisory Board, which may additionally comprise of experts across Institutes / Organizations.
6. The Centre shall also be free to enter into MOUs with other like-minded Institute / Organizations / Agencies / Research Groups across the globe without any financial liability on IIITA.
7. TO meet the academic Objective of the Centre, it may, out of its funds, hire Adjunct Faculty / Visiting Faculty / Scientist as may be felt necessary by the Centre.
8. To manage the administration and other financial needs, suitable manpower may be acquired generation.
9. The academic staff committing themselves towards the fulfillment of centre objectives shall owe their primary allegiance to any one of the departments existing in the Institute.
10. Periodic review towards the fulfillment of the academic objectives (s) of the Centre shall be taken by the Research Council of the Institute.
